

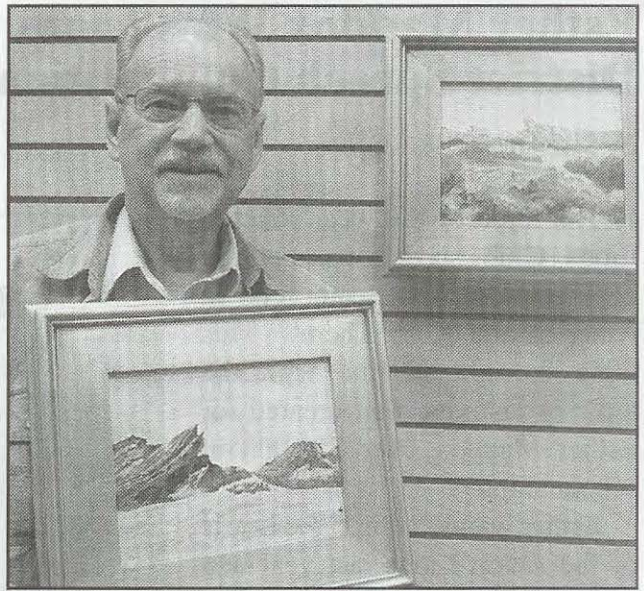
## Santa Clarita Artists Association “Spring Art Festival and Sale” Coming to Le Chene in Agua Dulce

On Sunday, April 28th, the members of the Santa Clarita Artists Association (“SCAA”) will be holding an outdoor event in the garden at Le Chene French Cuisine at 12625 Sierra Highway in Agua Dulce. Over 30 artists will be displaying their original artwork for the free enjoyment of the public. All art will be offered for sale to fund scholarships offered to promising High School art students. The club also presents other educational art opportunities in the Santa Clarita Valley.

SCAA has been the only non-profit Fine Art Association in Santa Clarita since 1989. The club gives artists direction and opportunities to learn, grow, and present themselves as professional artists worldwide.

One of the participating artists is Terry Sonntag, a long-time resident of Agua Dulce. Prompted by a plein air artist friend, Terry picked up a brush and put oil to canvas and never looked back. A few months later, he sold his first painting, a rendering of the Vasquez Rocks. The majority of his paintings capture views of our local areas: Vasquez Rocks, Bouquet and Placerita Canyons, Highway 126, Davenport Road and many Sierra Highway scenes.
